This is further to your request under the *Access to Information Act*, received on May 25, 2010, for the following documents:

Asking for information held by the CRTC concerning the level and percentage of debt held by non-Canadians as of August 31, 2009, in Canadian broadcast licensees, for individual licensees and for the Canadian broadcasting sector as a whole.

The Commission does not keep records of the information you are asking for. Ownership information is only available by individual broadcasting licensees. Such information includes the voting and some non-voting interest of Canadians and non-Canadians only. Information about debt instruments and other related documents from foreign parties is not collected in an application process unless it is required in a major ownership transaction that raises an issue about foreign ownership. For example, the CanWest / Alliance Atlantis and the BCE / Teachers transactions have such information available in their public applications which are accessible at <http://support.crtc.gc.ca/broadappl/broadapplform.aspx?lang=e>. We do however have on our web site the ownership charts for most of the existing broadcasters which provides percentages for their voting structure (<http://www.crtc.gc.ca/ownership/eng/ownership.htm>). Note that the date at the bottom of each chart is the date when the chart has been updated with certain information; it is not an indication that all of the information it contains have been confirmed on that date. Until a change is provided to that effect, all is deemed current.
