Re: Request for information regarding radio and television programming service callsigns – CRTC reference A-2015-00032 (19 October 2015)

I am in receipt of the CRTC's response to the above-noted request, in response to my request of 30 September 2015. I had requested a list of radio and television programming services, for the years 2009/10, 2010/11, 2011/12, 2012/13 and 2013/14, showing each service's callsign, the name of its licensee, the name of the location it serves (if any) and its CRTC undertaking identification number

The records sent by the CRTC consist of a covering letter and a 493-page PDF document saved on a compact disc ("A-2015-00032 final version"). This document appears to consist of a 466-page listing of broadcast distribution, radio and television undertakings, and a 26-page document entitled "Radio Fall 2009: Commercial Radio by Qualifier, Call sign – Excludes Ethnic". The 466-page list of undertakings includes information for "Licensee Name", "Undertaking Number" and "Call Sign Service Name".

Please clarify: does the CRTC's failure to provide conventional (over-the-air) television programming services' location mean that the CRTC does not have this information for the 2010, 2011, 2012 2013 and 2014 broadcast years?
