

"Provide a copy of any report dealing with the subject matter of Broadcasting Decision CRTC 2022-175 which the CRTC submitted to the Minister under section 25 of the Broadcasting Act regarding the CBC's contravention of or non-compliance with a condition of license, a CRTC regulation made under Part II of the Act or an order issued under subsection 12(2) of the Act."
