

Hi Brad,

I had a last minute thing yesterday so did not post anything else about the timing issue re your application.

But this morning I had a bit of spare time.

I looked at all the Part 1 renewal applications that the CRTC processed administratively – no hearing at all – in 2019, and added the date the applications were filed and the date of the decision. This lets me calculate “Days CRTC took to decide”.

The results are shown below, in two ways: first, sorted by Days for CRTC to decide, and then sorted by type of programming service and Days for CRTC to Decide. Briefly, while the average days taken for the CRTC to make decisions about all of these services was 360 days, the average time taken for discretionary services for all these services was
