This letter is further to your request of September 14, 2020, to obtain:

**“The CRTC's website includes pages describing its closed Part 1 applications. The pages list 622 broadcasting and telecom Part 1 applications (excluding licence renewals) between 1 January 2016 and 11 September 2020: Year 2016: 106 Broadcasting, 34 Telecom (Total: 143) 2017: 108 Broadcasting, 37 Telecom (Total: 145) 2018: 87 Broadcasting, 38 Telecom (Total: 125) 2019: 96 Broadcasting, 36 Telecom (Total: 132) 2020 (as of 11 September 2020): 54 Broadcasting, 23 Telecom (Total: 77) Total, 2016-2020: 454 Broadcasting, 168 Telecom (Total: 622) (A copy of the information used to compile this list, using the CRTC's Closed Part 1 Applications pages, is attached.) The CRTC from time to time returns Part 1 applications without posting them. In 2018, for example, the CRTC returned a Part 1 broadcasting application to SCFP: see <https://crtc.gc.ca/eng/archive/2018/lb180420.htm>. I am asking for a list of the 'Part 1 applications' that have been sent to the CRTC and returned by the CRTC or its staff without being posted to the CRTC's website, from 1 January 2016 to end of day 11 September 2020). Thank you.”**
