We note that, pursuant to the *Access to Information Act* (ATIA), you wish to obtain the following information:

“Please provide any documents written by the CRTC (in other words, not from third parties) from 1 January 2013 showing the number of BDU systems that offer a free local package service, as currently described in General Authorizations for Broadcasting Distribution Undertakings (<https://crtc.gc.ca/eng/publications/distga.htm>), under "Distribution of a local package".”
